**Announcing Active Democracy**: Change of Name – same plan

As reported in the <u>June Awakening Democracy</u>, the <u>Australian Democracy Foundation</u> (ADN) <u>#OurDemocracy Framework for a Fair Democracy project</u> launched. For a complex of reasons, they need to take over the name Our Democracy. So with regret but wanting that project to succeed the national group has agreed on the name change. The ACT group will follow suite.
