Eight new community independents join Helen Haines and Andrew Wilkie in the House of Representatives, making a crossbench of 16, with Bob Katter, Rebekah Sharkie and four Greens, while independents David Pocock and (ex-UAP) Ralph Babet join the two Jackie Lambie Network, two One Nation and 12 Green senators on the Senate crossbench.
